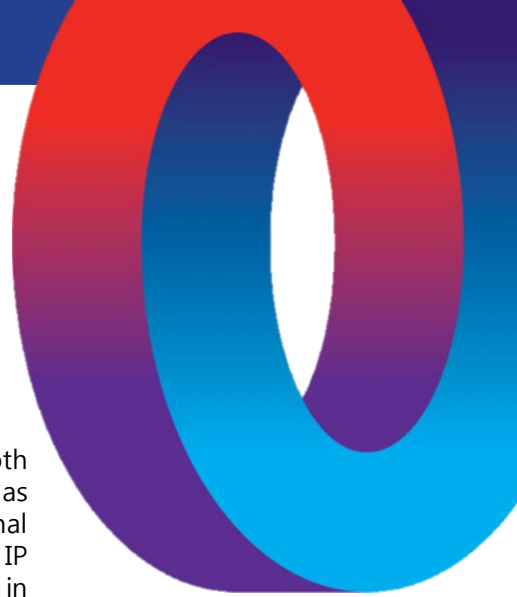

Grant L. Kim

Partner, LimNexus LLP, San Francisco

Grant Kim has deep expertise in both international arbitration and IP litigation. He has acted as counsel in numerous international arbitrations and in numerous patent and other IP lawsuits, and has also served as an arbitrator in patent license disputes. He is a Fellow of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators, Chair of its Northern California Chapter, and a member of the ICDR, KCAB, and HKIAC arbitrator panels and the Silicon Valley Arbitration and Mediation Center.

After working at big law firms for 30 years (25 at Morrison & Foerster in San Francisco and close to 5 at Kim & Chang in Seoul), Mr. Kim is moving in February of this year to LimNexus LLP, which provides a better platform for serving as an arbitrator and for representing Korean clients. His grandparents were among the first wave of Korean immigrants to the U.S in the early 1900's. He learned Korean as an adult while living and working in Korea as an English teacher and as a lawyer.

Phillip F. Shinn

Phillip Shinn is a career trial attorney, and a former Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals staff attorney.
